Preparing for your Plan Reassessment

Getting ready for a plan reassessment may seem overwhelming, but thorough preparation can make a world of difference. It's a wise strategy to plan ahead and ensure that your paperwork is well-organised.

Documentation is your key to a successful reassessment, so be sure to gather the essential information and documents necessary for reviewing your current NDIS plan and laying the groundwork for your next one.

This information will not only guide the review of your current plan but also help shape your goals for the next plan. It serves as crucial evidence for determining your required funding and facilitates communication with the NDIA regarding any changes.

Include the following information and evidence:

- Your current living arrangements.
- A breakdown of your current funded supports, outlining what you can do independently, what you need assistance with, and what you cannot do by yourself.
- What informal supports you have in place.
- A description of your what your day to day life looks like.
- Your goals and aspirations.
- A comprehensive review of the funding in your current plan.
- A well-reasoned plan with clear rationale for the funding needed in the next plan.
- Identification of any current or potential risks that you may be facing.


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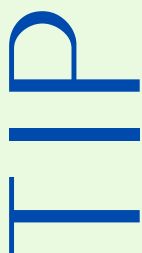
Once you've completed this process, consider sending a copy to your Local Area Coordinator (LAC) or Early Childhood Partner and your support coordinator or psychosocial recovery coach (if applicable) a few days before your scheduled plan reassessment meeting.
